Class fees: Sport Horse Breeding and Opportunity-\$35, Introductory through Fourth Level-\$45,

FEI and Freestyle-\$55

Office fees: Mandatory per horse/rider combination \$25

Qualifying fee: GAIG/USDF qualifying rides add \$10 to class fee

Post Entries: at discretion of show secretary \$10 per class addition/change

Late fee: \$25 late fee for all entries postmarked after closing date that are accepted.

NOTE: anyone not appearing for a scheduled ride without notify the show office will be scratched from the rest of their remaining classes (no refunds given).

Times—posted at www.canterburyshowplace.com and available by emailing the show secretary the Thursday before the show. Please make sure you check your ride times each day at the show incase changes have been made to the schedule.

2. **STABLING**-Permanent 12x12 stalls with full sliding doors. \$80 Friday 12:00pm to Monday 8:00 am, \$25 per horse for extra nights. \$25 per horse daily grounds fee for unstabled horses.

NON COMPETING HORSES Must fill out entry form with signatures, pay \$25 office fee plus stabling. Negative Coggins test required.

Stall assignments will be posted on the "stabling info" board at front of facility.

3. **ACCOMMODATIONS**-Host Hotel-Fairfield Inn by Marriot 352-332-8292 ask for Canterbury Rate! Other local hotels-La Quinta Inn 352-332-6466

Camper Hook Ups are located on grounds, \$35 per night. Send reservation and payment with entry.

- 4. **FOOTING AND RINGS -**20 X 60M in covered arena with sand/clay mix footing. 20 x 60m in outdoor ring and warm-up rings have fiber footing. Please lunge horses in grass areas only.
- 5. **DIRECTIONS-** 1-75 to exit #387 (SR26) go west 10 miles, Canterbury is on your right hand side.
- 6. **FOOD** food concession on grounds.
- 7. VETERNARIAN AND FARRIER- names and numbers will posted on show grounds in office, stabling info board and in show program.
- 8. **OPPORTUNITY CLASSES-**These classes are open to any breed, they are exempt from the USEF and USDF membership requirements as well as the \$16 USEF fee. Classes are run under USEF rules and exhibitors are subject to these rules.
- 9. **REFUNDS-** Office fees are not refundable after closing date. Class entries and stall fees will be refunded if horse is withdrawn on a vet cert. or rider with a medical certificate before 1st day of the show.

**IMPORTANT:** All entries shall be on the official entry form of the show. The entry form should be completed in every detail; otherwise, the record of wins may not be properly credited. The show management reserves the right to return any incomplete entry form. All entries must be accompanied by a complete payment. A fee of \$50.00 will be added to any account due if any person gives a non-negotiable check. Non-negotiable checks will be turned over to USEF per Rule XV, Article 1508 and AHA Chapter 6 of the current handbook.

- 10. **SHARPS DISPOSAL:** Competition management may fine any individuals including owners, exhibitors, trainers, or their agent up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments. Sharps disposals are available in the barn area.
- 11. MINORS who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of recognized competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motor vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violation of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of this child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from t he competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

#### USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 nonmember registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

Membership Requirements for USET-licensedTUSDF-recognized Competitions; Owners and iders, including foreign riders and owners who are not residents of the US, wishing to participate in a USEF-licensedUSDF-recognized competition as a rider or ownerMessee, must have either a USDF Group Membership, Participating Membership (PM), or have a USDF Non-Member (NM) identification number and pay the USDF NM fee. (Note: USDF business members can own horses but cannot compete as riders with their USDF BM.) Individuals cannot compete at a USEFicensedUSDF-recognized competition with a USDF Education Membership.

Horses competing at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions must have either a USDF Horse identification (HID) number or a USDF Lifetime Horse Registration (LHR), Proper credentials or verification certificates must be presented to the competition secretary.

Riders and owners wishing to participate in a USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competition, and not able to present the competition secretary with verification of a USDF membership or NM identification, and USDF LHR or USDF HID, must complete a USDF Competition Affidavit Form and pay the \$5 affidavit filing fee. A copy of a completed affidavit from another competition may also be used for verification purposes for up to 60 days. (Exception: Affidavits cannot be used at Great American Insurance GroupUSDF Regional Dressage Championships.)

Exceptions:

- Horses competing only in Individual Breed Classes (IBCs) at DSHB competitions, sires
  and dams of horses in DSHB group classes, where those sires or dams are not actually
  competing in the same competition, horses competing only in breed restricted dressage
  or DSHB classes at Regular Competitions (e.g. all Arabian, all Priesian, or all Morgan
  classes), or in USDF Introductory Level tests, Pas de Deux, Quadrille, FEI
  ParaEquestrian classes, are exempt from this requirement. Also exempt are horses
  ridden in leadine, exhibitions, games and races, classes for 4-H members, walk-trot,
  academy and opportunity classes.
  - Riders and owners/lessees competing only in classes which are exempt from the USDF HID requirements are also exempt from the USDF NM identification number and NM fee requirements. Also exempt are handlers of horses competing in DSHB In-Hand or Group classes.

# Memberships Defined

Participating Membership (PM): A membership issued to an individual directly by USDF. The membership year is December 1 through November 30. PMs are available for 1-year (\$75), 5-years (\$300), or life (\$1,500). A USDF Youth Participating Membership (YPM) is available for individuals who have not reached their 21th birthday by December 1 of the current membership year (\$60). A PM allows the member to compete at USEF-licensed/USDF-recognized competitions and to participate as a rider and/or ownerlessee for all Adequarifu/USDF Year-End Awards, Great American Insurance Group/USDF Breeders' Championship Series Finals and the Great American Insurance Group/USDF Regional Dressage Championship program.

Group Membership (GMI): A membership issued to an individual by USDF when the member name and dues are submitted to USDF through an afficiale Group Member Organization (GMO). The GM year begins December 1 and ends November 30. A GM allows the member to compete at 06/10


